a) Approval of Minutes: May 13---Approved

4) Old/Unfinished Business

a) Museum art piece---

The Fife History Museum proposed that the FPAC purchased "Valley Roundelay" by Lisa Kinoshita be moved to a more public location. The FHM has been in talks with the Fife Chamber of Commerce and have tentatively been working toward moving the piece to the bay window with appropriate lighting.

b) Artist in Residency Program (Cree)

\$450 was approved for Diane K (aka Ruby Reusable) as compensation for prep time versus the previously offered "materials cost".

Cree is continuing to contact Eduardo with a possible Saturday (or 2) workshop in November.

c) Mural/Artist Selection (Potter)

i) Update--- Savvy Jane was informed that she was chosen to be our Muralist. She will paint on a removable piece and the location will be determined. There is the possibility that the mural could be mounted indoors or outdoors.
