**DISCUSSION TOPICS**

**Non-Signalized Pedestrian Crosswalk**

Public Works Director Blount stated the City of Fife received a \$250,000 "Target Zero" federal grant to improve non-signalized pedestrian crosswalks throughout the City, and a \$23,000 Washington Traffic Safety Commission grant for three additional flashing beacons at school zone crosswalks. The project will be funded by those grants and funds from Fife's Public Safety Fund, which receives its revenues from safety camera enforcement of traffic signal violations, so that no portion of the funding is from general tax revenues of the city.

The work will be at 14 different locations around the city, and Blount reviewed the work to be done at the sites. Councilmembers asked questions about the project and Blount stated he would add crosswalks as the project progressed and if budget allowed for the additional work to be incorporated into the project.

**Fife Website Overview & Mega Menu**




City Manager Zabell presented information on the upcoming agenda items.
