CALL TO ORDER & ROLL CALL

Mayor Roscoe called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Mayor Roscoe expressed gratitude towards the District legislators for taking the time to meet with the City.

UPDATE & SESSION PRIORITIES FROM LEGISLATORS

Senator Zeiger, Representative Stambaugh and Representative McDonald each outlined their legislative priorities in Olympia, with some of the key topics being affordable housing, Capital budget, and homelessness.

FIFE'S 2018 LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES


The City's lobbyist Doug Levy outlined the City's legislative priorities. The top six priorities discussed with the legislators were:

- 2018 Supplemental Transportation Budget – 167/509 “Gateway” Project;
- Ensure Legislative Approval of \$2.6 Million Funding Advance for Port of Tacoma Interchange Phase I;
- Ensure Passage of a 2017-19 Capital Budget – Possible Funding for Inter-Urban Trail Project;
- Streamlined Sales Tax (SST) Mitigation Funding – Support 2018 Supplemental Operating Budget fund to reconcile SST Mitigation Funding Levels in Budget with Allocation Needed under EHB 2163;
- Support Supplemental Operating Budget Request for Additional Basic Law Enforcement Academy (BLEA) Training Slots; and


- Increase Funds & Local Options for Affordable Housing, Homelessness, Mental Health, and Opioid Prevention.
