- Coordination of the Sound Transit 3 project between Fife, Milton and Edgewood.
- Public Transportation and Fife, Milton and Edgewood being a strong voice to the Pierce Transit Board.
- Joint Board opportunities or Fife, Milton and Edgewood Joint Committee meeting on a quarterly basis.
- Partnering on services or offering joint services including, festivities.
- Various communication portals and informing the public.
- Collaborating together with the school district.
- A Fife, Milton and Edgewood applications for notifications and updates.
- Preparations for major events.


- Buying local and keeping local businesses.

Local residents left their email address for further correspondence.


Fife City Manager Kim asked the Councilmembers to let staff come up with next steps and bring information back at a later date.
