ORDINANCE NO. 1775

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTIONS 10.24.100 AND CHAPTER 12.12 OF THE FIFE MUNICIPAL CODE, AND ADDING A NEW SECTION 10.24.065 TO THE FIFE MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING PARKING INFRACTIONS

WHEREAS, FMC 12.12.010 currently lists several parking violations as misdemeanors which are more properly classified as parking infractions under FMC Chapter 10.24 Parking and Loading; and

WHEREAS, defendants who request hearings on parking infractions but fail to appear at the hearing waste valuable court time and resources; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, WASHINGTON
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new section 10.24.065 is hereby added to the Fife Municipal Code to read as follows:

10.24.065 Parking and storage for certain purposes.

A. No person shall park or store upon the city streets or rights of way any motor vehicle or other object for the purpose of displaying such motor vehicle or other object for sale, or for advertising the sale thereof.

B. No person shall park or store upon the city streets or rights of way any motor vehicle, camper, trailer, boat or other object, for the purpose of greasing or repairing such motor vehicle, camper, trailer, boat or other object, except that emergency parking for repairs upon a motor vehicle not requiring over one hour of total time shall be permitted.

C. No person shall park or store upon the city streets or rights of way any motor vehicle which is temporarily or permanently inoperative for any reason

whatsoever, including lack of proper license, except parking for emergency repairs as authorized in subsection (B).

D. Overnight parking, except automobiles, motorcycles, and pickup trucks, is prohibited on any street within the city.

E. Parking on any street within the city shall not at any time interfere with the normal flow of traffic.

Section 2. Section 10.24.100 the Fife Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.24.100 Monetary penalty for failure to respond to parking infraction.

If no response is made to a notice of infraction relating to a parking violation within 15 days from the date it is issued, the municipal court shall impose an additional \$25.00 monetary penalty in addition to the base monetary penalty for committing the parking violation. If the defendant fails to appear at a requested hearing on a notice of infraction relating to a parking violation, the municipal court shall impose an additional \$25.00 monetary penalty in addition to the base monetary penalty for committing the parking violation.

Section 3. Fife Municipal Code section 12.12.010 is hereby amended to read as follows:

12.12.010 Prohibited storage.

The following parking and storage is prohibited upon the city streets and rights-of-way:

A. Parking or storage, at any time or for any reason, of a boat, boat trailer, house trailer, travel trailer, mobile home, camper or any other vehicle or object incapable of self-locomotion;

B. Storage of building materials, sand, gravel, sawdust, beauty bark, rocks or any other materials of any kind whatsoever for a period in excess of that reasonably necessary for its removal from the street onto private property; any period in excess of 48 hours shall be presumed to be unreasonable;

C. Storage of rubbish of any kind for any period of time, except during a city authorized cleanup campaign.


Section 4. The Title to Chapter 12.12 of the Fife Municipal Code is hereby amended to "Storage on Streets."

Section 5. Each and every provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable. In the event that any portion of this Ordinance is determined by final order of a court of competent jurisdiction to be void or unenforceable, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions thereof provided the intent of this Ordinance can still be furthered without the invalid provision.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after publication as required by law. A summary of this Ordinance may be published in lieu of the entire Ordinance, as authorized by State law.
