ORDINANCE NO. 1803

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTIONS 5.06.080, 9.09.040, 9.13.010, 9.21.010, 9.22.040, 9.23.010, 9.27.010, 9.29.010, 9.33.010, 9.37.010, 9.39.010, 9.43.010, 9.54.010, 9.59.010, 9.69.010, AND 9.77.010 OF THE FIFE MUNICIPAL CODE TO REMOVE INCORPORATION OF FELONIES, TO CORRECT CRIMINAL CODE LEVEL, AND TO UPDATE RCW CAPTIONS AS INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE INTO THE FMC

WHEREAS, the City does not have the authority to prosecute felonies; and

WHEREAS, some of the RCWs that have been incorporated by reference into the FMC included felonies, without exclusion; and

WHEREAS, some of the RCW caption headings have changed since they were incorporated into the FMC; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires the FMC to be as accurate and legally precise as possible; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5.06.080 of the Fife Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.06.080 Penalty.

Violation of FMC 5.06.050 or any failure to display the cabaret license pursuant to FMC 5.01.020 or operating a cabaret without a valid cabaret license, or during a period of license suspension, is a misdemeanor. Upon the conviction of a first offense there shall be a minimum fine imposed of \$500.00 plus costs of enforcement and prosecution. A second offense for violating any provision of this chapter within 12 months of a first conviction shall be charged as a gross misdemeanor, and there shall be a minimum fine imposed of \$1,000 plus costs of enforcement and prosecution. The maximum penalty to be imposed upon a second conviction within a 12 month period is a \$1,000 fine and/or 364 days in jail.

Section 17. Each and every provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable. In the event that any portion of this Ordinance is determined by final order of a court of competent jurisdiction to be void or unenforceable, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions thereof, provided the intent of this Ordinance can still be furthered without the invalid provision.

Section 18. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after publication as required by law. A summary of this Ordinance may be published in lieu of the entire Ordinance, as authorized by State law.


