ORDINANCE NO. 1828

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, REPEALING FIFE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 9.08.030

WHEREAS, Fife Municipal Code Section 9.08.030 currently makes the receiving of compensation for practicing fortune telling, tea leaf reading, palmistry or clairvoyance a misdemeanor crime; and

WHEREAS, fortune telling, tea leaf reading, palmistry or clairvoyance can be a legitimate, "for entertainment purposes" business, as well as potentially being used in recognized religions; and

WHEREAS, legitimate businesses should be regulated under the current licensing and zoning codes; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 9.08.030 of the Fife Municipal Code is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Each and every provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable. In the event that any portion of this Ordinance is determined by final order of a court of competent jurisdiction to be void or unenforceable, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions thereof provided the intent of this Ordinance can still be furthered without the invalid provision.




