ORDINANCE NO. 1870

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT OF 35 MILES PER HOUR ON NORTH LEVEE ROAD EAST BETWEEN THE EAST CITY LIMITS AND 54TH AVENUE EAST

WHEREAS, the speed limit on North Levee Road East between the east city limits and 54th Avenue East has been posted with a speed limit of 35 miles per hour for many years; and

WHEREAS, through an oversight, the City of Fife never formally adopted a speed limit for this section of road when the area was annexed to the city, though it was posted at 35 miles per hour by the County prior to annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director has reviewed the traffic history of this segment and there has been no undue history of speed related accidents, nor speed infractions; and

WHEREAS, the speed limit has been reviewed with the City's transportation consultant who has deemed a speed limit of 35 miles per hour appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the City also has the authority under Article XI, Section 11 of the State Constitution to regulate its city streets in the interests of public health, safety, and welfare; and

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 10.12.040 of the Fife Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.12.040 Speed limits designated on certain streets.

The speeds on the following streets shall be set as follows:

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

54th Avenue East from the intersection of Valley Avenue East north to the intersection of 54th Avenue East and Pacific Highway East (Old U.S. Highway 99) including the 54th Avenue East Overpass from the Station 0.00 to 0.18 (from the north line of 20th Street East)	30 mph
54th Avenue East, north of the intersection of 54th Avenue East and Pacific Highway East (Old U.S. Highway 99) north to the intersection of 54th Avenue East and Taylor Way	35 mph
54th Avenue East Extension from the intersection of 54th Avenue East and Taylor Way north to the north city limits	20 mph
56th Avenue East	20 mph
62nd Avenue East from 18th Street East to 20th Street East	20 mph
62nd Avenue East from 20th Street East to Valley Avenue East	30 mph
63rd Avenue East	20 mph
70th Avenue East	35 mph

Section 2. Each and every provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable. In the event that any portion of this Ordinance is determined by final order of a court of competent jurisdiction to be void or unenforceable, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions thereof, provided the intent of this Ordinance can still be furthered without the invalid provision.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after publication as required by law. A summary of this Ordinance may be published in lieu of the entire Ordinance, as authorized by State law.


