ORDINANCE NO. 1889

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON REPEALING FIFE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 5.62 RELATED TO SOCIAL CARD GAMES

WHEREAS, on October 14, 2014 the Fife City Council passed an ordinance amending the City of Fife Zoning Code to allow “Gambling Premises”; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fife zoning code’s definition of “Gambling Premises” includes “Social Card Rooms” as defined by RCW 9.46.0282; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fife Municipal Code section 5.62.010 entitled “Social card games – Prohibition” prohibits “Social card games” in the City of Fife except for those currently located within the city of Fife with a valid Fife business license and a valid license from the state of Washington; and

WHEREAS, FMC Chapter 5.62 would conflict with the City of Fife zoning code if it (FMC Chapter 5.62) were left unchanged; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Fife Municipal Code Chapter 5.62 entitled “Social Card Games” is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Each and every provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable. If any provision of this ordinance should be deemed to be unconstitutional or otherwise contrary to law by court of competent jurisdiction, then it shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections so long as the intent of the Ordinance can be fulfilled without the illegal section.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after publication as required by law. A summary of this Ordinance may be published in lieu of the entire Ordinance, as authorized by State law.




