ORDINANCE NO. 1926

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, ADDING A NEW CHAPTER 3.40 TO THE FIFE MUNICIPAL CODE CREATING THE AQUATIC SERVICES FUND**

WHEREAS, City has operated a swim center for over thirty years, and

WHEREAS, swim center operations and programs have grown considerably since the swim center's inception, and the City finds that it is in the best interests of the City to establish aquatic services fund to track all revenues and expenses related to the operation of the Fife Swim Center; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new Chapter 3.40 is hereby added to the Fife Municipal Code, titled "Aquatic Services Fund."

Section 2. A new section 3.40.010 is hereby added to the Fife Municipal Code to read as follows:

**3.40.010 Created**

The aquatic services fund is hereby created in the city of Fife accounting system.

Section 3. A new section 3.40.020 is hereby added to the Fife Municipal Code to read as follows:

**3.49.020 Purpose.**

The purpose of this fund is to track all expenses related to the Fife swim center, and to account for the revenues and expenses related to the operation of the swim center facilities.

Section 4. A new section 3.40.030 is hereby added to the Fife Municipal Code to read as follows:

**3.40.030 Source of revenue.**

There shall be placed into the aquatic services fund all moneys received from any source that is to be expended on the creation, operation, maintenance, expansion,

furnishing or any other expenses related to the city's swim facility. Also to be deposited into this fund are any moneys received for the use of the city of Fife swim facilities or for services offered as part of the city of Fife swim center operation.

Section 5. A new section 3.40.040 is hereby added to the Fife Municipal Code to read as follows:

**3.49.040 Use of funds.**

All city expenses related to the swim center facilities, including but not limited to capital expenditures and operation and maintenance expenditures shall be paid from this fund.

Section 6. Each and every provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable. In the event that any portion of this Ordinance is determined by final order of a court of competent jurisdiction to be void or unenforceable, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions thereof provided the intent of this Ordinance can still be furthered without the invalid provision.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after publication as required by law. A summary of this Ordinance may be published in lieu of the entire Ordinance, as authorized by State law.
