ORDINANCE NO. 1932

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SUBSECTION 2.52.040 TO ADD CORRECTIONS OFFICER, CORRECTIONS SERGEANT, CORRECTIONS CAPTAIN, DIVISION MANAGER, AND ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND REPEALING CHAPTER 2.59 OF THE FIFE MUNICIPAL CODE ELIMINATING THE DETENTION SERVICES DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City Council by Ordinance No. 1863, created a detention services department separate and distinct from the police department, to administer and operate the jail facility and the corrections and detention services of the City, and to remove corrections officer and corrections sergeant from civil service since these positions would no longer be within the police department; and

WHEREAS, since the creation of the detention services department, the demand for Fife detention services has been greatly decreased by the termination of the City's jail services contract with the City of Tacoma; and

WHEREAS, as such, it will now be more efficient to eliminate the detention services department and return the administration and operation of detention services to the police department; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subsection 2.52.040(a) of the Fife Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. The following positions are created in the Fife police department: assistant chief, captain, corrections captain, sergeant, patrol officer, community services officer, police specialist, detective, corrections officer, corrections sergeant, police confidential secretary, police clerk, communications/records supervisor, division manager, administrative assistant, and communications and records specialist.


Section 2. Repealer. Chapter 2.59 of the Fife Municipal Code is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. Each and every provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable. In the event that any portion of this Ordinance is determined by final order of a court of competent jurisdiction to be void or unenforceable, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions thereof provided the intent of this Ordinance can still be furthered without the invalid provision.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after publication as required by law. A summary of this Ordinance may be published in lieu of the entire Ordinance, as authorized by State law.


