ORDINANCE NO. 1940

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON ADOPTING THE 2012 EDITION OF THE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT MANUAL FOR WESTERN WASHINGTON AND AMENDING SUBSECTIONS 15.32.020(J), 15.32.050(A) AND 15.34.020(F) OF THE FIFE MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Ecology periodically adopts new Stormwater Management Manuals for Western Washington of statewide applicability; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Ecology adopted the 2012 Stormwater Management Manuals for Western Washington, as amended, in December 2014; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the public health, safety and welfare of the public would be served by adopting the State Stormwater Manual; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subsection 15.32.020(J) of Fife Municipal Code Section is amended to read as follows:

J. "Manual" or "stormwater management manual" means the 2012 Edition of the Stormwater Management Manual for Western Washington, as amended in December 2014, adopted by reference and prepared by Ecology that contains BMPs to prevent or reduce pollution.

Section 2. Subsection 15.32.050(A) of Fife Municipal Code Section is amended to read as follows:

A. Stormwater Management Manual Adopted. The 2012 Edition of the Department of Ecology's Stormwater Management Manual for Western Washington, as amended in December 2014, is hereby adopted by reference as the stormwater management manual for the city of Fife and is referred to as the "manual" in this chapter. Approval standards and minimum requirements for all regulated activities shall be as set forth in the manual.

Section 3. Subsection 15.34.020(F) of Fife Municipal Code Section is amended to read as follows:


F. "Manual" or "stormwater management manual" means the 2012 Edition of the Stormwater Management Manual for Western Washington, as amended December 2014, adopted by reference and prepared by Ecology that contains BMPs to prevent or reduce pollution.

Section 4. Each and every provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable. In the event that any portion of this Ordinance is determined by final order of a court of competent jurisdiction to be void or unenforceable, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions thereof provided the intent of this Ordinance can still be furthered without the invalid provision.


