ORDINANCE NO. 1973

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE
COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO.
1964 TO CORRECT A SCRIVENER'S ERROR**

WHEREAS, On September 26, 2017 the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 1964 regarding a salary schedule for certain employees not covered by a collective bargaining agreement; and

WHEREAS, Section 4 of the Ordinance contains a scrivener's error that requires correction; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 4 of Ordinance No. 1964 is hereby amended as follows:

Section 4. Effective January 1, 2018 and on January 1st of each successive year, the salaries paid to employees not covered by a collective bargaining agreement and the minimum and maximum salary ranges set forth in the Exhibit A attached hereto shall be increased by an amount equal to 100% of the increase in the CPI-W Seattle-Tacoma-Bremerton Index as measured for the prior 12 month period beginning and ending in June and as published by the U.S. Department of Labor, with a minimum increase of 2% and a maximum increase of 4%.


Section 2. Each and every provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable. In the event that any portion of this Ordinance is determined by final order of a court of competent jurisdiction to be void or unenforceable, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions thereof provided the intent of this Ordinance can still be furthered without the invalid provision.

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Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after publication as required by law. A summary of this Ordinance may be published in lieu of the entire Ordinance, as authorized by State law.




