A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE,
PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, NOMINATING
Dick Godwin FOR A POSITION ON THE PIERCE
COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL ZONE DISTRICT ADVISORY
COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, Pierce County created the Pierce County Flood Control Zone District in 2012 to provide funding and policy oversight for flood protection projects and programs in Pierce County; and

WHEREAS, the Flood District's board of supervisors is forming an advisory committee to review and recommend an annual capital budget for the Flood District, including capital improvement program projects and funding levels; and


WHEREAS, the Flood District Board will take advisory committee recommendations under advisement as it votes to approve the capital improvement budget for the District; and

WHEREAS, the advisory committee will play an important role in assuring that there is broad community input in the development of the capital budget and projects for flood control projects; and

WHEREAS, the Fife City Council has the opportunity to submit one nomination from amount its members to serve on the advisory committee; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Fife City Council hereby nominates Dick Godwin to represent the City of Fife on the Pierce County Flood Control Zone District Advisory Committee and authorizes and directs the City Manager to execute and submit the proscribed application form along with a copy of this resolution to the Flood District.
