A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON ACCEPTING CONSTRUCTION OF THE 62nd AVENUE SIDEWALK AND SHEFFIELD TRAIL AND 20th STREET CROSSWALK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AS COMPLETE

WHEREAS, the Council appropriated funds for 62nd Avenue improvements consist of construction of curb, getter, planting strip, and sidewalk on the east side of 62nd Ave from the existing sidewalk at the Bella Sonoma apartments to 20th Street East, and the Sheffield Trail improvements consist of constructing a five foot wide asphalt trail connecting the existing trail east of the Bella Sonoma apartments to 20th Street East, and constructing a crosswalk on 20th Street East west of the library; and

WHEREAS, because of the proximity and timing of each project, they were combined in the advertisement for bid as one project in order to obtain more competitive bids (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Project was advertised for bid and Active Construction, Inc. was awarded the contract as the lowest responsive bidder; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fife Public Works Department has determined that the Project is complete and ready for final acceptance by the City Council; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Fife City Council hereby accepts the construction contract with Active Construction, Inc. for construction of the 62nd Avenue sidewalk and Sheffield Trail and 20th Street crosswalk improvement project as complete.
