

RESOLUTION NO. 1560

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH KPG, INC. FOR DESIGN WORK FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO PACIFIC HIGHWAY EAST

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) awarded \$1,660,800 to the City of Fife for construction of pedestrian improvements on the north side of Pacific Highway East from 54th Avenue East to 66th Avenue East; and


WHEREAS, the Fife City Council included the grant and the local share of the project cost in its adopted 2013-2014 biennial budget; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project also includes a second left turn lane from westbound Pacific Highway to southbound 54th Avenue and conversion of overhead utilities to underground; and

WHEREAS, the City advertised for consultants for design work for the project and selected KPG, Inc. as most qualified and has negotiated a scope of work and contract terms with KPG; now therefore


BE IT RESOLVED that the Fife City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute a contract with KPG, Inc. in the amount of \$473,863 for design of improvements on Pacific Highway East between 54th Avenue East and 65th Avenue East, including pedestrian improvements, a second left turn lane onto southbound 54th Avenue East, and changes to channelization beyond the project limits as necessary to implement the turn lanes, in a form approved by WSDOT and the City Attorney.
