

RESOLUTION NO. 1576

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON ACCEPTING THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE 70TH AVENUE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT BY ACTIVE CONSTRUCTION, INC AS COMPLETE

WHEREAS priority number 1 on the Six Year Transportation Improvement Program (2012 to 2017) was the widening and reconstruction of 70th Avenue East from I-5 to Valley Avenue (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bids for the construction of the Project and bids were opened on April 13, 2012; and

WHEREAS, upon tabulation and evaluation of all bids, Active Construction, Inc. was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Fife, by Resolution No. 1469, thus authorized a contract with Active Construction, Inc. to construct the Project in the original contract amount of \$7,448,182.60, including tax; and

WHEREAS, change orders resulted in an actual total contract amount of \$8,113,202.19; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fife Public Works Department has determined that Active Construction, Inc. has completed the Project; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Fife City Council hereby accepts the construction contract with Active Construction, Inc. for construction of improvements to 70th Avenue East from I-5 to Valley Avenue as completed.
