

RESOLUTION NO. 1593

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON ACCEPTING CONSTRUCTION OF THE 54th AVENUE PAVEMENT PRESERVATION CONSTRUCTION PROJECT AS COMPLETE

WHEREAS, The Fife City Council appropriated \$1,300,000 for grinding and overlaying 54th Ave E from State Route 99 to north City limits in the 2013 capital budget; and

WHEREAS, that budget number included a \$750,000 federal grant from the Surface Transportation Program (STP) for pavement preservation, but comes with the "strings" that handicapped ramps associated with all crosswalks impacted by the project must be brought up to current standards; and

WHEREAS, as a result the project scope included replacement of pedestrian crosswalk ramps at the intersections 4th, 7th, 12th and 15th Street E to current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards; and


WHEREAS, the City advertised for bids for the construction of the project and council awarded the project to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, Miles Resources, LLC on August 13, 2013 for an amount of \$927,126.70; and


WHEREAS, due to certain cost savings and additions, the total cost for construction was \$850,499.44; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fife Public Works Department has determined that Miles Resources, LLC, has completed the project; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Fife City Council hereby accepts the construction contract with Miles Resources, LLC, for construction of the 54th Avenue Pavement Preservation Construction project as completed.
