

RESOLUTION NO. 1606

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON ACCEPTING
CONSTRUCTION OF THE SHEFFIELD TRAIL
IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AS COMPLETE

WHEREAS, Sheffield Trail is an asphalt pedestrian pathway that connects Valley Ave E to 20th Street; and

WHEREAS, the Fife City Council 2014 amended budget included \$120,000 to install root barrier and repave the south half of Sheffield Trail; and

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bids for the construction of the project and bids were opened on January 29, 2014; and


WHEREAS, upon tabulation and evaluation of all bids, Northern Asphalt was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder and was awarded the contract; and

WHEREAS, the project consisted of installing 1907 linear feet of root barrier about 2 feet below the ground surface to deter any future roots from damaging the over 200 tons of new asphalt placed to pave the trail; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fife Public Works Department has determined that Northern Asphalt has completed the project; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Fife City Council hereby accepts the construction contract with Northern Asphalt for construction of the Sheffield Trail Improvement project as completed.
