AND AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION


WHEREAS, the City Manager has submitted his resignation, which will be effective at midnight, August 12, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that that the appointment of an Interim City Manager will assure the effective and efficient operation of City government until a replacement for the City Manager is hired; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that an orderly transition to a new City Manager would be furthered by promoting the Deputy City Manager to serve as Interim City Manager until the new City Manager is selected and commences employment with the City; now, therefore



Re: Appointment as Interim City Manager

Dear Subir:

I am pleased to appoint you as the interim City Manager for the City of Fife, effective August 13, 2014. This appointment shall remain in effect from August 13, 2014 until the new City Manager commences employment with the City. Your terms of employment, as set forth in your employment letter dated January 31, 2014, shall remain unchanged, except as modified by this letter.

During the time that you serve as the interim City Manager, you will be responsible for your normal duties as the Deputy City Manager, as well as the City Manager duties. Your base salary during this appointment shall be increased by 6%. You will continue to accrue benefits, and "seniority" as set forth in your employment letter. Your appointment as interim City Manager shall automatically end without further notice on the date the new City Manager commences employment with the City, and your terms of employment on that date shall then revert back to employment agreement terms, without regards to the content of this letter.

Since this is an interim appointment, there is no requirement that you reside within the City of Fife.
