RESOLUTION NO. 1615

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT WITH THE FIFE POLICE GUILD FOR COMMISSIONED OFFICERS FOR THE YEARS 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017

WHEREAS, the Fife Police Guild is the authorized bargaining representative for commissioned officers of the Fife Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the current collective bargaining agreement expired on December 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the City's negotiating team has reached a tentative agreement with the Fife Police Guild for a new five (5) year contract to be effective January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2017, and

WHEREAS, the Guild ratified the Agreement on July 31, 2014, and the City's negotiating team has recommended that the Council also ratify the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed the proposed Collective Bargaining Agreement and finds it is in the best interests of the City and its employees to authorize the City Manager to execute the Agreement; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby ratifies the agreement with commissioned officers reached between the negotiating teams for the Fife Police Guild and the City as attached hereto as Exhibit A and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the agreement substantially in the form attached hereto. The City Manager is also authorized to make minor changes to any subsequently discovered typographical or grammatical errors or the like, not affecting the substance of the agreement.
