A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON ACCEPTING
CONSTRUCTION OF THE NON-SIGNALIZED PEDESTRIAN
CROSSING PROJECT AS COMPLETE

WHEREAS, the City planned and budgeted the non-signalized pedestrian project for construction commencing in 2014; and

WHEREAS, the project consisted of installation of school zone solar flashing system, sidewalk, curb ramps, pavement markings, signage and other improvements at various non-signalized pedestrian crossings within the City; and


WHEREAS, the City advertised for bids for the construction of the project and bids were opened on January 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, upon tabulation and evaluation of all bids, BPCI Earthworks, LLC was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fife Public Works Department has determined that BPCI Earthworks, LLC has completed the project; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Fife City Council hereby accepts the construction contract with BPCI Earthworks, LLC for construction of the non-signalized pedestrian crossing project as completed.
