

RESOLUTION NO. 1643

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON ACCEPTING
CONSTRUCTION OF SWIM CENTER ENERGY EFFICIENCY
UPGRADES PROJECT AS COMPLETE

WHEREAS, the City planned and budgeted the swim center energy efficiency upgrades project for construction commencing in 2014, aided by grants from the Washington State Department of Enterprise Services (DES) and two separate energy reduction rebate programs offered by Tacoma Public Utilities; and

WHEREAS, the City in conjunction with DES advertised for bids for the construction of the project and upon tabulation and evaluation of all bids, Integrity Energy Services was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fife Parks, Recreation, and Community Services Department has determined that Integrity Energy Services has completed the project; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Fife City Council hereby accepts the construction contract with Integrity Energy Services for construction of the swim center energy efficiency upgrades project as completed.
