

RESOLUTION NO. 1684

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE,
PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE
CREATION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF A PILOT WATER
CONSERVATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, water conservation programs help communities address water supply and wastewater treatment challenges, and help can help customers reduce their utility bills; and

WHEREAS, providing customers with low flow shower heads, sink aerators, and rebates for low flow toilets has proven to be a cost effective water conservation measure; and

WHEREAS, implementation of such a program in Fife would be beneficial to the water and sewer utility, utility customers, and the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Fife City Council hereby creates the following water conservation program:

1. The City shall offer to Fife water and sewer utility customers, at no cost, low flow shower heads and sink aerators.

2. The City shall offer coupons to Fife water and sewer utility customers redeemable through a supplier located in Fife, for up to \$100 per low-flow toilet purchased for use in Fife.

3. The program shall be implemented by the Public Works Director and the Economic Development & Marketing Program Manager or their designees.

4. The program shall be funded by water and sewer capital improvement funds. City staff is hereby directed to prepare a budget amendment for this expenditure for council approval.


5. The program shall be offered through December 31, 2015. The city council will evaluate the program in the first quarter of 2016 to consider future continuation.
