

RESOLUTION NO. 1690

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON ACCEPTING CONSTRUCTION OF THE 58TH AVENUE SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AS COMPLETE

WHEREAS, the City of Fife obtained a \$115,000 HUD block grant in 2014 for the reconstruction of the sidewalks along the east side of 58th Avenue East, between Fife High School and Harry Smith Road; and


WHEREAS, the project will replace existing sidewalk that lies in a low poorly drained area with a new sidewalk at higher elevation, and will also provide improved pedestrian ramps at intersections and at the pedestrian crossing to the Emerald Park Apartments, and provide a subsurface storm drainage system to reduce local flooding in the area, which includes the main entrance to the Lakes at Fife apartment complex; and

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bids for the construction of the project and upon tabulation and evaluation of all bids R.W. Scott Construction Co. was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and


WHEREAS, the City Engineer has determined that R.W. Scott Construction Co. has completed the project; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Fife City Council hereby accepts the construction contract with R.W. Scott Construction Co. for construction of the 58th Avenue sidewalk improvement project as completed.
