

RESOLUTION NO. 1699

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, EXTENDING THE
WATER CONSERVATION PROGRAM THROUGH
DECEMBER 31, 2016

WHEREAS, water conservation programs help communities address water supply and wastewater treatment challenges, and help can help customers reduce their utility bills; and

WHEREAS, providing customers with low flow shower heads, sink aerators, and rebates for low flow toilets has proven to be a cost effective water conservation measure; and

WHEREAS, on September 22, 2015 the City Council adopted Resolution No. 1684 creating a water conservation program offering to Fife water and sewer utility customers, at no cost, low flow shower heads and sink aerators, and offering coupons redeemable through a supplier located in Fife, for up to \$100 per low-flow toilet purchased for use in Fife; and

WHEREAS, the program was offered as a pilot program to end on December 31, 2015, with a stipulation that the Council would evaluate the program in the first quarter of 2016 to consider future continuation; and


WHEREAS, while several of the motel owners have shown interest in purchasing the low-flow toilets, they have indicated that they have not had time to make the purchases before the deadline; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that it is in the City's interest to continue the program through 2016; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Water Conservation Program created by Resolution No. 1684 is hereby extended through December 31, 2016.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council will evaluate the program in the first quarter of 2017 to consider future continuation.
