

RESOLUTION NO. 1708

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON ACCEPTING CONSTRUCTION OF THE 70<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE ASPHALT REPLACEMENT PROJECT AS COMPLETE

WHEREAS, The City's 2015/2016 biennial budget includes \$1,350,000 for the design and construction of the replacement of the asphalt pavement on 70th Ave E from the Union Pacific Rail Road to 43rd Street East; and

WHEREAS, the project was supported by a \$750,000 federal grant provided by the Puget Sound Regional Council (PSRC) for construction and \$600,000 from a combination of the public safety and general fund; and

WHEREAS, the Project included reconstruction of non-compliant curb ramps to meet ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) standards; and

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bids for the construction of the Project and upon tabulation and evaluation of all bids, Miles Resources, LLC was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has determined that Miles Resources, LLC has completed the Project; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Fife City Council hereby accepts the construction contract with Miles Resources, LLC for construction of the 70<sup>th</sup> Avenue Asphalt replacement project as completed.
