

RESOLUTION NO. 1725

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON ADOPTING THE 2017 TO 2022 SIX YEAR TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Pursuant to RCW 35.77.010, the City Council is required to review, update, and extend its six-year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) on an annual basis, and such review shall include review of the work accomplished under the program and determine current city transportation needs; and

WHEREAS, City Staff caused to be prepared a proposed Six Year Transportation Improvement Program for the period of 2017 to 2022; and


WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission considered the plan at a public meeting on May 2, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City Council conducted a public hearing on the proposed plan as recommended by the Planning Commission on June 14, 2016; and

BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Fife Washington adopts the Six Year Transportation Improvement Program from 2017 to 2022, attached hereto as Exhibit "A," superseding all prior adopted Six Year plans.
