A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON TEMPORARILY CHANGING THE LOCATION OF CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS

WHEREAS, the City of Fife City Hall building is a one-story, wood framed, stucco sided building approximately twenty years old; and

WHEREAS, generally described, moisture intrusion has damaged the exterior envelope of the building requiring the removal of the existing stucco siding and substantial removal and replacement of structural sheathing, wood stud framing, sill plate and hold-downs, roof truss repair, along with interior drywall removal and replacement; and

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bids for the construction of the project as required by law, and the contact was awarded to Good News Group, Inc., the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the work will make Fife City Hall council chambers unavailable for City Council meetings and study sessions from February 13, 2017 to July 13, 2017; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to designate another place for City Council meetings during that period, and the Fife Municipal Court courtroom at the James Paulson Criminal Justice Center located at 3737 Pacific Highway East, Fife, WA is the best alternative; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that from February 13, 2017 through July 13, 2017 regular Fife City Council meetings shall be held at the Fife Municipal Court courtroom at the James Paulson Criminal Justice Center located at 3737 Pacific Highway East, Fife, WA, at the regularly scheduled time and date.

BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED that from February 13, 2017 through July 13, 2017, City Council special meetings and study sessions shall also be held at the Fife Municipal Court courtroom at the James Paulson Criminal Justice Center located at 3737 Pacific Highway East, Fife, WA, unless otherwise publicly noticed as provided by law.
