

RESOLUTION NO. 1774

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON ACCEPTING CONSTRUCTION OF THE 70TH AVENUE EAST AND 26TH STREET EAST SIGNAL PROJECT AS COMPLETE

WHEREAS, the 66th Avenue East LID was formed through Resolution 1605 on July 8th 2014. Council budgeted \$260,000 in 2016 and \$4,893,065 in 2017/2018 for the 66th Ave E LID; and

WHEREAS, a portion of this project scope includes upgrading a “flashing yellow” beacon at 70th Avenue East and 26th Street E, constructed with the 70th Avenue East Phase II project to a fully functioning signal; and

WHEREAS, the signal improvements included conduit, conductors, wiring, vehicle and pedestrian displays, controller cabinet, striping, detection loops and signing; and

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bids for the construction of the Project and upon tabulation and evaluation of all bids, Totem Electric of Tacoma, Inc. was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has determined that Totem Electric of Tacoma, Inc. has completed the Project; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Fife City Council hereby accepts the construction contract with Totem Electric of Tacoma, Inc. for construction of the 70th Avenue East and 26th Street East Signal Project as completed.
