

RESOLUTION NO. 1782

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR A TAP GRANT FOR THE INTERURBAN TRAILHEAD PROJECT AND TO PREPARE A BUDGET AMENDMENT.

WHEREAS, the Interurban Trail is a principal regional non-motorized facility in South King and North Pierce Counties, providing city to city connectivity and localized transportation & recreational access, and Interurban Trail extension is a component of non-motorized improvements included in the SR 167 Puget Sound Gateway project; and

WHEREAS, the Interurban Trailhead Project (the "Project") will extend the Interurban Trail from the terminus of a previous City of Milton project and construct a new trailhead access point at 70th Avenue E in Fife, replacing a temporary link of the Trail and locate it in the planned permanent position out of the way of the SR 167 connection to Interstate 5; and

WHEREAS, Project will also move the existing interim trail and trailhead and


WHEREAS, the Project is eligible for a Transportation Alternatives Program grant from the Puget Sound Regional Council, which requires a local match, which city staff estimates to be approximately \$75,000; and

WHEREAS, the Project is identified in the City of Fife Comprehensive Plan, Future Non-Motorized Operations section; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for a TAP grant from Puget Sound Regional Council for the Interurban Trailhead Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the council hereby authorizes a local match of \$75,000 for the Project, and directs the City Manager to prepare and present a budget amendment for \$75,000 for the Project.
