

RESOLUTION NO. 1799

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON ACCEPTING CONSTRUCTION OF THE CJC AND FREEMAN ROAD MAINTENANCE FACILITY SECURITY FENCING PROJECT AS COMPLETE

WHEREAS, in 2016 funds were budgeted to install security fencing at the Freeman Road Maintenance Facility ("FRMF") and the Criminal Justice Facility ("CJC"); and

WHEREAS, the scope of work at the FRMF included a fenced area for five seized vehicles. The fence is 8 feet in height with 5 full height double swing doors and is located at the north property line. The FRMF scope also includes a new cantilever gate (over 16 feet in length) that separates the office and shop/vehicle wash area. The gate is operated by underground (in the asphalt pavement) loops or onsite and remote pushbutton; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work at the CJC included adding new cantilever gate and over 321 feet of security fencing. The cantilever gate is also operated by underground (in the asphalt pavement) loops and manually inside the building. The fencing is 6 feet in height with three stands of barb wire stanchions; and

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bids for the construction of the project and Secoma Fence, Inc. was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has determined that Secoma Fence, Inc. has completed the project; now, therefore


