

RESOLUTION NO. 1808

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH ACTIVE CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE 66TH AVENUE EAST IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the 66th Avenue East Improvement Project (the "Project") is included in the City's 2018-2023 Transportation Improvement Program, and will be partially funded through LID 14-1 and partially by the City; and


WHEREAS, the Project consists of a new City street beginning at the south end of the developer-built 66th Avenue E south of 20th Street, and continuing through to 26th Street E., including sidewalks, illumination, signalization, and storm drainage collection, conveyance, detention, pump station and treatment; and

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bids for the construction of the Project as required by law; and

WHEREAS, bids were opened on December 19, 2017 and, upon tabulation and evaluation of all bids, Active Construction, Inc. was determined by the City to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute on behalf of the City of Fife, a contract with Active Construction, Inc. in the form set forth in the bid documents, for the construction of the 66th Avenue East Improvement Project, in the bid amount of \$3,026,434.88, including sales tax.
