

RESOLUTION NO. 1843

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH COLVICO, INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE SR 99 UNDERGROUND ELECTRICAL SERVICE PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Fife has contracted with Johansen Construction Company for the SR99 Pedestrian and Stormwater Improvement Project. In general, the project consists of pedestrian and stormwater improvements on the north side of SR 99 (Pacific Highway East) from 54th Avenue East to 65th Avenue East, addition of a second left turn lane from westbound Pacific Highway to southbound 54th Avenue; and, conversion of overhead utilities to underground; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of the undergrounding of overhead franchise utilities as part of the project described above, six buildings within the project area will need new connections to the underground power distribution system from Tacoma Public Utility (TPU) and underground communication systems ("SR 99 Underground Electrical Service Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bids for the construction of the Project as required by law; and

WHEREAS, bids were opened on June 15, 2018 and, upon tabulation and evaluation of all bids, Colvico, Inc. was determined by the City to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute on behalf of the City of Fife, a contract with Colvico, Inc. in the form set forth in the bid documents, for the construction of the SR 99 Underground Electrical Service Project, in the bid amount of \$144,638.76, including sales tax.
