

RESOLUTION NO. 1855

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH PUGET PAVING & CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE PACIFIC HIGHWAY EAST PRESERVATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, in 2018 Fife was awarded a \$1,423,322.00 federal National Highway Performance Program (NHPP) grant through the Federal Highway Administration for preservation of Pacific Highway East; and


WHEREAS, the project limits extend from the West City Limits to Port of Tacoma Road and from Alexander Ave. E. to Willow Rd. East, and includes road resurfacing and installation of ADA compliant curb ramps (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bids for the construction of the Project as required by law; and

WHEREAS, bids were opened on November 29, 2018 and, upon tabulation and evaluation of all bids, Puget Paving & Construction, Inc. was determined by the City to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute on behalf of the City of Fife, a contract with Puget Paving & Construction, Inc. for construction of the Pacific Highway East Preservation Project, in the bid amount of \$1,570,284.00, including sales tax.
