As a result of their efforts, Fife High School captured five Nisqually League championships, two West Central District III championships, and sent four teams on to state competition (one repeat state champion) so far.

The girls' cross-country team finished the season undefeated won the Nisqually League championship. They finished 3rd at the WCD III and were a best ever 9th at the State Meet.

8. Nisqually League Academic Achievement Awards: This award is given to seniors that have a 3.75 GPA or above.
