***REPORT IN BRIEF:***

To allow City Manager to sign a contract with Gerling and Associates for an amount not to exceed \$330,000.00 as awarded by the Department of Community, Trade, and Economic Development for the Mobile Command Vehicle Project.

***BACKGROUND:***

This is the culmination of our mobile command vehicle project. This cooperative project was the result of the efforts and energy of several departments and agencies within the region. This is the first project of this type in the region, to include partners from multiple disciplines (in addition to police and fire) to include schools, emergency medical, health and mental health agencies.

This resolution allows the City Manager to enter into a contract with the lowest responsible bidder.

***RECOMMENDATIONS:***

Fife City Council pass Purchase Resolution #1261 to allow the City Manager to sign the contract with Gerling and Associates.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A MOBILE COMMAND VEHICLE, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THE \$330,000.00 AWARD FROM THE STATE OF WASHINGTON

WHEREAS, the State of Washington, the Fife City Council, and the Fife Police Department believe that there is a need to have a regional mobile command vehicle available in the event of a major event or natural disaster; and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington awarded the City of Fife through its appropriations process the amount of \$330,000.00 to purchase a mobile command vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fife conducted an RFP process and Gerling and Associates was determined to be the lowest responsible bidder; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Fife City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute a contract with Gerling and Associates in an amount not to exceed \$330,000, including sales tax, to purchase a mobile command vehicle in accordance with the terms and specifications as set forth in the RFP.


