REPORT IN BRIEF:

Our annual PSAP (911 Center) contract with Pierce County expired December 31, 2008. This contract replaces the expired contract.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Fife has a 911 answering center and provides this service for several cities. The equipment and trunk phone lines are controlled and owned by both Pierce County and the State of Washington. This contract allows us a portion of the funds collected via the 911 tax structure.

DISCUSSION:

This is the standard contract that we have had in place with PCDEM over the years.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Fife will receive \$9,468.00 per year (3% increase over 2008)


ALTERNATIVE COURSES OF ACTION:

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF FIFE, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO
AN AGREEMENT WITH PIERCE COUNTY DEPARTMENT
OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT REGARDING THE 911
DISPATCH CENTER (PSAP) FUNDING**

WHEREAS, the City of Fife Police Department has served as an emergency dispatch center for 911 services and has previously entered into agreements with Pierce County and other jurisdictions regarding that service; and

WHEREAS, the existing agreement has expired on December 31, 2008 and it is necessary to enter into another agreement in order to continue with the service; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Pierce County regarding 911 (PSAP) dispatch services, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A and by reference incorporated herein.
