



SENIOR CITIZEN AND DISABILITY UTILITY DISCOUNT APPLICATION

The City of Fife offers a discount on utility services for residential customers who qualify as:

- Low income **AND** disabled (to qualify as disabled the applicant must receive funds from a disability program as a result of a disability that prevents them from working)
- OR**
- Low income **AND** over 62

These rates apply to residential customers only. There are two programs. **Program 1** rates are 70% of the standard utility rate for water, sewer and storm drainage. For this program the combined household income must be less than the amount in the chart below.

Program 2 rates are 50% of the standard utility rate for water, sewer and storm drainage. For this program the combined household income must be less than the amount in the chart below.

4	\$3,578
5	\$4,151
6	\$4,723

If your household size is over 6 people and you are not sure if you qualify, you can call us at (253) 922-2489.

Once a customer qualifies for this program, the rate becomes effective on the next billing cycle.

Along with the application, please include the following items:

- **Utility Billing from the City of Fife**
- **Proof of income for all members of household**
 - A copy of your tax return for the preceding calendar year or yearly social security statement (if you are not required to file and this was the only income) must be provided. Bank statements are not accepted as proof.
 - **IF YOU DID NOT FILE A TAX RETURN, PLEASE EXPLAIN THE REASON:**

- **Proof of identification and age** (usually in the form of a driver's license or state issued ID)
- **Proof of disability** (usually in the form of a social security statement)

Alternative Screening Process

An alternative screening process is available to applicants who prefer not to leave copies of their documentation. Applicants have the option to request an interview to determine eligibility. The interview process requires a prescheduled appointment. During your appointment, the required documentation (noted above) will be verified and your eligibility will be determined.
