You must have this form returned to the court by the due date to avoid additional fees.

A DECLARATION OF NON-RESPONSIBILITY may not be used by employers/principals to transfer responsibility to their employees/agents. A vehicle registered to an employer/principal that is driven by an employee/agent remains in the "care, custody, and control" of the employer/agent and thus, the employer/principal is responsible for payment of a photo infraction by submitting payment directly to the court or by requesting a hearing in his or her name. Photo infractions will NOT appear on your driver's license record at the Department of Licensing, nor will it affect your insurance.

In the spaces above, you must accurately write the 9 digit number that appears in the middle of the front of the Notice of Infraction, the license plate number and state for the vehicle involved in the infraction. Please write clearly and make sure you record the information accurately. If the Notice of Infraction Number is unclear or incorrect, the Court will not be able to match your declaration to your infraction, and the infraction will go to a collection agency if not paid.
