FIFE CITY COUNCILMEMBERS SWORN INTO OFFICE

Fife, WA – Three Fife Councilmembers were sworn in at the January 14 Fife City Council meeting.

Fife Municipal Court judge Kevin Ringus administered the oath of office to Dee-Dee Gethers. Fife residents will recall Gethers from her previous service on Fife City Council. She was appointed to the council in 2011 and was elected in 2015 to serve another term.

Ringus also administered the oath of office for Kim Roscoe, who was reelected to another term in November. Roscoe previously served elected terms from 2002-2009, 2016-present and appointed terms in 2011 and 2013.

Pierce County Superior Court Judge Helen Whitener administered the oath of office for Bryan Yambe, who was reelected in November for another term on the Fife City Council. Yambe has served on the council since 2013.

Coming up at the February 11 Fife City Council meeting, councilmembers will select the mayor and deputy mayor.
