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SENIOR PROGRAMMING TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED

Fife, WA – The health and safety of our citizens is the highest priority for the City of Fife. In keeping with advice from health officials regarding public events, the City of Fife will suspend all senior activities and programs at the Fife Community Center and Fife Aquatic Center effective Wednesday, March 11 and continuing through at least Friday, April 3. The program suspension will be reevaluated at that point and any continuation or changes will be communicated through the City of Fife’s website (cityoffife.org) and social media channels.

These precautions are a result of the ongoing COVID-19 health recommendations. As with any infectious virus, this is an evolving situation. Please check the city’s website at cityoffife.org for the most current information. During any outbreak, safe reliable information is important. The City of Fife recommends that citizens also consult the Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department for up-to-date health information at tpchd.org. The Washington State Department of Health also is a reliable resource with up-to-date information at doh.wa.gov/Emergencies/Coronavirus.
