Senior and Disability Utility Discount Program

You may be eligible for help with your City of Fife utility bill.

Overview of Program

The City of Fife offers a discount on utility services to eligible customers to help them manage their water, sewer and stormwater bills.



If you are low income and at least 62, or if you are low income and disabled you may qualify for a discount of up to 50%.
