

# 20th St Preserv-Industry-54th Ave

## Project Description

This project invests in the preservation of Fife's street system. The project will place 2 inches of asphalt over the existing pavement. The project limits are from Industry Drive E to 54th Avenue E, a distance of approximately 6,100 feet. The project will require some full depth patches, milling to correct subgrade issues, as well as tying into existing gutters. The project will also construct ADA improvements. The main intent of the project is to provide a new wearing course over the extents of the existing roadway.

## Project Justification

The existing pavement is showing significant wear. The pavement rating, based on a national Pavement Condition Index, ranges from 48 to 58 on a scale of 0 to 100 and is considered to be in "Marginal" to "Fair" condition. This busy minor arterial street is a main east-west thoroughfare through Fife with connections to Tacoma to the west and Milton and Edgewood to the east. A number of sidewalk curb ramps do not meet ADA requirements and will be corrected as part of the project.
